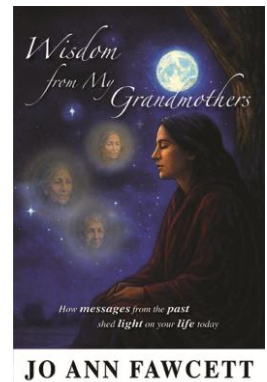
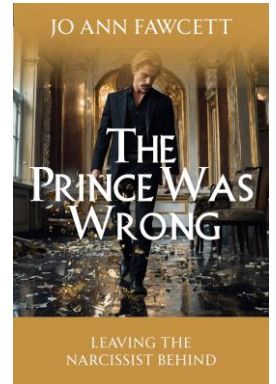
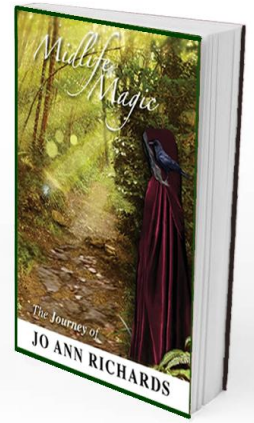




Jo Ann Fawcett
